#### Audience:

max. 400 people

**Stage:** 14m x 12m optimum size

Performing area 10m x 10m, covered with white dancefloor Additional:

1,5m – 2m at stage left and stage right, covered with black dancefloor 2m in front of curtain, covered with black dancefloor

Curtain: building foil white, with structure, "German curtain" (flying curtain)

from the company size : h=6.5m / w= 11.1m

Backdrop: cyclorama white (from the theatre)

size : h = 6 m / w = 12 m

sidelegs black and black over the cyclorama

For the last part of the performance the male audience is invited to come on stage. We place 100 floor cushions behind the curtain, we are serving tea on stage for the audience (stairs to reach the stage!). We have to prepare tea for 100-200 persons close to the stage and we need boiled water. The tea has to be served 50 minutes after the start of the show. The production will provide the glasses, the tea, thermal bottles and the floor cushions. But if you have a trolley for us it will help a lot. We need one person for the cushions and to prepare the tea in the glasses!


